Scripture: Hebrews 12:1-2 (Amplified) - Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who by faith have testified to the truth of God's absolute faithfulness], stripping off every unnecessary weight and the sin which so easily and cleverly entangles us, let us run with endurance and active persistence the race that is set before us...

3.	<u>APATHY</u> - Lack of interest; passive; indifferent
4.	DECLUTTER - to remove unnecessary items

5. **<u>DISINFECT</u>** - to cleanse of infection; destroy disease or germs

6. **<u>DISCERN</u>** - to distinguish, to separate out by diligent search

C. _____ - to commit oneself again to a project

a. Galatians 5:1 - Stand[a] fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.
