### OUR SAVIOR

John 1:29. The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (NLT)

**Introduction:** Our new series is entitled: Sin-Savior-Salvation. Last week, we discussed our sins and discovered we need a Savior. This week we will teach: **1)** Why we need a Savior, **2)** What is a Savior?, and **3)** Who is our Savior?

**REVIEW: Our Sin** 

DEFINITION OF SIN: Sin is disobedience to God's law.

**1 John 3:4**. Everyone who sins **breaks the law**; in fact, **sin is lawlessness**. (NIV)

ALL HAVE SINNED: original sin and inherited sin (Adam):

Romans 5:12. When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned. (NLT)

- Spiritual Death soul separated from God relationally
- > Physical Death soul is separated from the Body temporarily
- Eternal Death soul is separated from God eternally

MESSAGE #1: Our Sin

- a) Separates us from God (death) Isaiah 59:2
- b) Makes us enemies of God (hostility) Romans 8:7
- c) Condemns us before God (punishment) 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9

Quote: "When someone breaks the law, do they receive love or justice?"

2 Peter 3:9. The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being **patient for your sake**. He does not want **anyone to be destroyed**, but wants everyone to **repent** (believe the gospel). (NLT)

#### We must accept these three facts:

- 1. First man Adam sinned (original sin)
- 2. We're all born sinners (inherent sin)
- 3. We're guilty and condemned before God (eternal punishment)

Today's Message: Our Savior: Sin explains why we need a Savior."

1. Why do people reject a Savior?

- a) They believe they are *inherently* good
- b) They love the *culture* of this world
- c) They do not want to be *rejected* by the culture

John 3:20. All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed.

# 2. What is a Savior?

- a) A person who can *atone* for our sins
- b) A person who can *save us* from our sins
- c) A person who can *reconcile us* back to God

## 3. Who is our Savior?

John 1:29. The next day John saw\_\_\_\_\_ coming toward him and said, "Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (NLT)

**St. John 3:16**. "For this is how **God loved** the world: **He gave** his one and only Son, so that everyone who **believes** in him will **not perish** but have **eternal life**. (NLT)

2 Corinthians 5:21. For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the \_\_\_\_\_\_ for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. (NLT)

Mark 10:45. "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many." (NLT)

Isaiah 53:5-6. But he was **pierced** for our **rebellion**, **crushed** for our **sins**. He was **beaten** so we could be **whole**. He was **whipped** so we could be **healed**. All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the Lord **laid on him the sins** of us all.

**2 Corinthians 5:19**. For God was in Christ, \_\_\_\_\_\_ the world to himself, **no longer** counting people's **sins against them**. And he gave us this wonderful **message** of reconciliation. (NLT)

"If we don't understand God's **holiness** and His **hatred** for sin and sinners, we cannot be in **awe** and **appreciate** God's **love for us** through the **suffering** and **death** of Jesus Christ on the cross!"

John 8:24. "That is why I said that you will die in your sins; for unless you

\_\_\_\_\_ that I AM who I claim to be, you will die in your sins."

(NLT)

Jesus Christ: Not only Savior of the world, but our personal Savior!
