Resurrection Sunday, April 21, 2019

Introduction: Our new series is entitled: Sin-Savior-Salvation. Last week we discussed our *Savior*. This week we will conclude with our *Salvation*. We understand our sin and our need for a Savior, now we will learn how to accept our salvation.

Points to our Message

1. OUR SIN - ADAM

Romans 5:12. When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned. (NLT)

We must accept these three facts about sin:

- a) Adam sinned (original sin)
- b) Adam's sin brought death (judgment of sin)
- c) Adam's sin made everyone born after him a sinner (inherent sin)

Quote: "If you **don't recognize** you're a **sinner** before God and the **judgment** upon your life is **death**, the need for a **Savior** becomes **meaningless**."

2. JESUS CHRIST - OUR SAVIOR

Three facts about a Savior:

- a) They must be able to pay the wages for our sins
- b) They must be able to save us from our sins
- c) They must be able to reconcile us back to God

John 1:29. The next day John saw <u>JESUS</u> coming toward him and said, "Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (NLT)

I John 4:10. This is real love-not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

Quote: "When we **stop** and **meditate** on God's **holiness** and our **sinfulness**, we should stand in **awe** and in **appreciation** of **God's love** for us, which is **verified** by Christ's death on the cross for **our sins!**"

Question: Why would a good God allow bad things to happen?

2 Peter **3:9**. The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being **patient for your sake**. He does not want **anyone to be destroyed**, but wants everyone to **repent** (believe the gospel). (NLT)

3. OUR SALVATION - THE GOSPEL

Romans 1:16. For I am not ashamed of the **gospel** of Christ, for it is the **power** of God to **salvation** for everyone who **believes**, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (NKJV)

"The gospel has the power to save those who believe in Christ."

1 Corinthians 15:3. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, ^{4.} and that he was **buried**, and that He **rose again the third day** according to the Scriptures, ^{5.} and that He was **seen** by Cephas, then by the twelve. (NKJV)

Three	facts	ahout	OUR	Sal	vation:

a)	We must be	of our sins
b)	We must become	by our faith
c)	We must	to live for Chris

Points to Salvation:

- a) Commitment of Salvation:
- 2 Corinthians 5:15. He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them.
- b) **Security** of Salvation:

Hebrews 10:14. For by that **one offering** he **forever** made **perfect** those who are **being made holy.** (NLT)

- c) **Exclusivity** of Salvation:
- John 8:24. "That is why I said that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I Am who I claim to be, you will die in your sins." (NLT)

Acts 4:12. "There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved." (NLT)
