Introduction: In this series, "The Book of Faith", I want to share with you the life changing principles of how to walk with God by faith. The first chapter of the book is entitled, "Faith in God."

Points to Message:				
1.	Faith	in God is for relationship.		
Hebrews 11:6. But without faith <i>it is</i> <u>impossible</u> to <u>please</u> <i>Him</i> , for he who comes to God <u>must believe</u> that He is, and <i>that</i> He is a rewarder of those who <u>diligently seek</u> Him. (NKJV)				
		Faith pleases God (satisfies and delights) Faith in God acknowledges two things: ➤ He exists (God is real) ➤ He rewards diligent seekers (pay wages)		
Application : "A person who seeks God by faith has the assurance they will be paid by God for their diligence."				
2.	Faith	in God is complete in Him.		
"Faith in God is putting your complete trust, belief, assurance, confidence, dependence, and expectations in Him."				
	A	We are wired to have faith in someone or something Examples : SelfFlyingOccupationMoneyHealth		
2 Corinthians 5:7. For we walk by faith, not by sight. (NKJV)				
	a) b)	We walk with God by faith (He generates) We do not walk with God by our sight (mind & emotions)		

Hebrews 11:1. Now **faith** is the **substance** of things **hoped for**, the **evidence** of things **not seen**. (NKJV)

c) God develops our faith, not our senses

- a) Faith apprehends God's word
- b) Faith is the **proof** you **possess** what you **do not see**
- c) Faith is present-tense

Romans 4:17. As it is written: "I have made you a father of many nations." He is our father in the sight of God, in whom he believed—the God who gives life to the dead and calls into being things that were not. (NIV)

- a) God's faith: "I have made you a father of many nations."
- b) Principle: "Faith <u>calls things</u> that <u>do not exist</u> as <u>though they</u> <u>did</u>."

Faith in God, trust in what God promises and calls out those promises that do not exist as though they did."

3. Faith in God comes by _____ His Word.

Romans 10:17. So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (NKJV)

- a) Faith comes by hearing
- b) Hearing comes by God's Word
- c) Obedience is proof of your faith

Faith in God is **not** a **mental affirmation** of God's Word. Faith in God is a **trust** in God's word that **compels** you to **act in obedience** to what God says.

Hebrews 11:8. By faith Abraham **obeyed** when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. (ESV)
