Introduction: We are in a series entitled, **"The Faith Manual**." Our objective in this series is to develop your faith in God and your faith walk on earth. Last week, we covered **Chapter 1** – *Faith in God*; this week, we will cover **Chapter 2** - Saving Faith in Christ.

Introduction: Chapter 1 – Faith in God – 2 Corinthians 5:6-7

1. Faith in God is <u>required</u> for relationship with Him. (Hebrews 11:6)

"Faith in God **pleases** Him (satisfies and delights) and acknowledges two things: God **exists** and He makes **faith payments** to those who **persistently** seek Him by faith."

"Faith in God will cost you before it pays you!"

2. Faith in God is putting your <u>complete trust</u> in Him. (2 Corinthians 5:7)

"All of my <u>beliefs</u>, <u>reality</u>, <u>confessions</u>, <u>assurance</u>, <u>reliance</u>, <u>patience</u>, and <u>expectations</u> are placed in God."

"God is developing our faith in Him, not our senses."

3. Faith in God increases by hearing His Word (Romans 10:17)

"Faith in God <u>confesses</u> God's words, which <u>do not exist</u> as though <u>they did</u>."

"God's <u>Word</u> becomes your <u>beliefs</u>, <u>reality</u>, <u>confessions</u>, <u>assurance</u>, <u>reliance</u>, <u>patience</u>, and <u>expectations</u>, even though His Word may be <u>contrary</u> to your circumstances."

Today's Message: Chapter 2 - Saving Faith in Christ

1. You're saved by grace through faith

Ephesians 2:8-9. For by <u>grace</u> you have been <u>saved through</u> <u>faith</u>, and that <u>not of yourselves</u>; it is the <u>gift of God</u>, not of works, lest anyone should boast. (NKJV)

- Grace saved you
- > Faith received the grace
- God gifted you with both the grace and faith

"Saving faith in Christ is putting your complete <u>trust</u> in the gospel of Christ."

2. You hear the gospel, you repent, and you believe

Mark 1:14-15. Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. **Repent**, and **believe** in the **gospel**. (NKJV)

Romans 10:8-9. But what does it say? "The <u>word is near you</u>, in <u>your mouth</u> and in <u>your heart</u>" (that is, the <u>word of faith which we preach</u>): that if you <u>confess</u> with your mouth the Lord Jesus and <u>believe</u> in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will <u>be saved</u>. ^{10.} For with the <u>heart</u> one <u>believes unto</u> righteousness, and with the <u>mouth confession is made unto</u> salvation. (NKJV)
