Introduction: We are in a series entitled, "The Faith Manual." Our objective in this series is to **develop** your faith in God that gives **life** to your faith walk on earth. Last week we covered **Chapter 1 – Faith in God**, this week we will cover **Chapter 2 - Faith in Christ**.

Review: Chapter 1 – Faith in God

2 Corinthians 5:7. So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. For we walk by faith, not by sight.

1. Faith in God is **required** for relationship with Him.

2. Faith in God is putting your complete trust in Him

Trust: assurance, patience, confession, reliance and expectations

3. Faith in God increases by hearing God's Word.

Hearing: attentive-introspective-subjective

Faith in God:

- Pleases God (satisfies-gratifies-delights)
- Matures you in God (moved by unseen reality)
- Receives faith payments from God

Today's Message: Chapter 2 - Faith in Christ

Acts 4:12. There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved." (NLT)

"Faith in Christ is putting your **complete trust** in the **salvation** that is in Jesus Christ."

1. Faith in Christ _____ us

Ephesians 2:8-9. For by <u>grace</u> you have been <u>saved</u> through <u>faith</u>, and that not of yourselves; it is the <u>gift</u> of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. (NKJV)

- **Grace** is the source (favor-benefit-power)
- Salvation is the gift (finished work of Christ)
- **Faith** is the means (method we obtain)

2. Faith in Christ _____ us

Mark 1:14-15. Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. <u>Repent</u> and <u>believe</u> in the <u>gospel</u>. (NKJV)

- Preach gospel: God's word spoken and written
- Repent remorse-change-direction
- **Believe** transform: conviction-convinced-conform

Exodus 24:7. Then he took the Book of the Covenant and <u>read it aloud</u> to the people. Again they all responded, "<u>We will do</u> everything the Lord has <u>commanded</u>. <u>We will obey</u>." (NLT)

- Hear "read it aloud" (attention-reflective-receive)
- Believe "we will do" (repent-trust-transform)
- > **O**bey "we will obey" (conform-act out what is in the mind)

3. Faith in Christ _____ us

James 2:26. Just as the body is dead without breath, so also faith is dead without good works. (NLT)

Ecclesiastes 9:10. Whatever your <u>hand finds</u> to do, do it <u>with your might</u>, for in the grave, where you are going, there is neither working nor planning nor knowledge nor wisdom. (NIV)
