Introduction: In this series, "The Faith Manual", I want to share with you the life changing principles of how to walk with God by faith. We have discussed: Chapter 1 - Faith in God and Chapter 2 - Faith in Christ. Today, we will discuss Chapter 3 - Living by Faith.

**2 Corinthians 5:6-7**. So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Introduction: Review

#### Chapter 1 - Faith in God - 2 Corinthians 5:7

- 1. Its **required** for relationship with Him.
- 2. It's putting your complete trust (obedience) in Him.
- 3. It **comes** by **hearing** God's Word.

# Chapter 2 - Faith in Christ

- 1. Saves us: Ephesians 2:8-9
  - By Grace
  - ➤ Through **Faith**
  - > Not of Yourselves or Works
  - ➢ It's a Gift of God

Salvation: 1) repentance – turn from sin, 2) faith in God, and 3) produces good works

- Transforms us: Exodus 24:7
  - a) **H**earing
  - b) Believing
  - c) Obeying
- 3. Aligns us: Hear, Heart, Head and Hands.
  - a) **B**elieve from your <u>Heart</u> (inspired-affection-intimacy)
  - b) Repent in your Head (informed-knowledge-truth)

c) Interests with your <u>Hands</u> (involved-works-sacrifice)

#### Today's Message: Chapter 3 – Living by Faith

**2 Corinthians 4:16.** Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. <sup>17.</sup> For our **light affliction**, which is but for a **moment**, is **working for us** far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory,

<sup>18.</sup> while we do not look at the things which are seen, but the things which are not seen. For the things **seen are temporary**, but the things which are **not seen** are eternal. (NKJV)

- Do not lose heart
- Outward Man (perishing) and Inward Man (renewing)(You're Saving)
- Light affliction-moment (You're Suffering)
- Working for us eternal weight of glory (You're Storing)
- Do not look at the things which are seen
- > But the things which are <u>not seen</u>
- Seen things are <u>temporary</u> and unseen things <u>eternal</u>
  (You're Seeing)
