**Introduction:** We are in a new series entitled: **Dynamics of Godly Relationships**. The objective of our series is to teach the principles of godly relationships, so we can better our current relationships. Today, we are going to talk about **God's** *Triangular* **Relationship**.

Scripture: "The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these." Mark 12:29-31 (NIV)

Introduction: Objective

- Improve our relational skills (godly)
- Examine ourselves (self-aware)
- Live at peace with all people (application)

**Importance:** Having **godly** relational skills are **imperative** for the **social order** of our **homes**, **church**, and **society**.

**Definition:** A relationship is a **connection** between two or more people who **relate** to one another based upon their **expectations** of the relationship.

## **Disposable Relationships:**

- 1. Value It's fight or flight
- 2. Unusable- It's broken
- 3. Replaceable I can get another

## 3 Levels of Relationship:

- 1. **Self-interest** "I" (what do you offer consumerism)
- 2. **Soulmate** "We" (we get one another similarities)
- 3. Sacred "Hallow" (see people through God's eyes)

## 3 Principles of Relationship

Principle #1. God created humans for relationship.

Reference: Genesis 1:26-28

Principle #2. God created humans to be relational.

Reference: Genesis 2:18

**Principle #3.** God created relationships for <u>connection</u>. Genesis 3:23-24, James 5:16

- a) Connection
  - 1) **Attraction** "bone of my bones"
  - 2) Affection "flesh of my flesh"
  - 3) Attachment "leaves to be united"
- b) Closeness we disclose ourselves

Points to the Message: Mark 12:29-31

- 1) Fears
- 2) Failures
- 3) Faults

PT1. Love matters
v.30. <b>LOVE</b> the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. v.31. The second is this: ' <b>LOVE</b> your neighbor as yourself.' There is <b>NO COMMANDMENT GREATER</b> than these. Mark 12:29-31 (NIV)
<b>Definition</b> : God's <b>endless</b> love comes from His will to be <b>selfless</b> , <b>sacrificial</b> , and <b>generous</b> to do what is in the <b>best interests</b> for those he has <b>chosen to love</b> .

<b>PT2.</b> Love God
v.30. <b>Love</b> the Lord your <b>God</b> with <b>all</b> your <b>heart</b> and with <b>all</b> your <b>soul</b> and with <b>all</b> your <b>mind</b> and with <b>all</b> your <b>strength</b> .
