An ongoing requirement for a relationship with God, is the ability to hear and know His voice. A Christ follower is a person who can hear and know the voice of God. This morning we're going to look at how to hear and know God's voice through the prophet Samuel's call of God.

Introduction: Knowing God's voice is essential

Jeremiah 7:22-23 (ESV)

v.22. For in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, I did not speak to your fathers or command them concerning burnt offerings and sacrifices. v.23. But this command I gave them: 'Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be my people. And walk in all the way that I command you, that it may be well with you.'

1. Obey my voice 2. I will be your God 3. You shall be my people 4. Walk in all the way (teachings) Promise: It will be well with you Reference: Deuteronomy 8:3

John 10:27 (ESV)

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.

- Hear my voice attentive
- I know them relationship
- ≻ They follow me – obedience

Reference: Deuteronomy 8:3

Points to the Message: Samuel's Call

1 Samuel 3:9. So he said to Samuel, "Go and lie down again, and if someone calls again, say, 'Speak Lord, your servant is listening.'" So Samuel went back to bed. 10. And the Lord came and called as before, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel replied, "Speak, your servant is listening."

1. Ask God to speak

Jeremiah 29:12. Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. 13. You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart. (ESV)

2. Prepare to listen

Proverbs 4:20. My child pay attention to what I say. Listen carefully to my words. 21 Don't lose sight of them Let them penetrate deep into your heart, v.22. for they bring life to those who find them, and healing to their whole body.

- a) "Pay attention" attitude
- b) "Listen carefully to my words" focus
- c) "Don't lose sight of them. Let them penetrate deep into your heart" – meditate
- d) "Keep them within your heart" carry out

b) Have Discernment - Jesus (Matthew 16:17, 23)

"Jesus **discerned** the **voice of God** based upon the **mindset of God** and the **mindset of a man**."

- 2) Align you with God's authority Hebrews 13:17
- 3) Agree with the Scripture Acts 17:11
- 4) Stand under confirmation I Corinthians 14:29
- 5) Motivate you to be like Christ Romans 8:29
- 6) Give you peace John 14:27
- 7) Match your gifts and calling Romans 12:6
