Ephesians 1:9-10 (NLT)

v.9. God has now revealed to us his mysterious will regarding Christ-which is to fulfill his own good plan. **v.10.** And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring **everything** (race) together under the authority of Christ-everything in heaven and on earth.

> What is God doing through the Church?

2 Corinthians 5:18-19 (ESV)

v.18. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the **ministry of reconciliation**; **v.19.** that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the **message of reconciliation**.
