I Peter 1:16. For the Scriptures say, "You must be holy because I am holy." (NLT)

#### **Review:**

1. **Be Content** – Christ strengthens you to be satisfied with whatever you have under any conditions. Philippians 4:11-13

"Troubles test the authenticity of our faith in Christ and produces contentment."

2. Do Not Fear – Faith or fear is derived by what you put your focus upon – Faith in Christ. Matthew 14:22-36

"God uses adverse conditions to reveal Himself to us."

Message: Living Holy

**Difference:** Legalism and Holiness

- **Legalism** attempts to earn living holy by your works and behavior.
- Holiness is an attribute of God alone; God declares we are holy by our relationship with Him.

"Can you live holy and be part of our progressive culture?"

21<sup>st</sup> Century Church: modernism-method-message

"We categorize sin as acceptable and unacceptable."

"All sins are unacceptable to God."

#### Points to the Message:

**Command**: "You must be **holy**." Why: "I am holy"

1. Living Holy: God is \_\_\_\_\_ – God's holiness is an attribute not shared by creation.

# Definition of God's Holiness:

- a) God is perfect in character
- b) God is morally pure (sinless)
- c) God is set apart (different from the rest)

# Reference: Isaiah 6:3-8 (NLT)

2. Living Holy: Be \_\_\_\_\_ – God declares you holy because of the natural outgrowth of being in relationship with Him by grace and faith in Christ.

Leviticus 20:26 (NLT) You must be holy because I, the Lord, am holy. I have set you apart from all other people to be my very own."

### Living Holy:

- a) Be perfect (character)
- b) Be morally pure (sinless)
- c) Be set apart (different from the rest)

References: Ephesians 1:4, Ezekiel 44:23, Hebrews 5:14

**Question:** How is your lifestyle **different** from those who do not walk with Christ?

3. Living Holy: Perfecting \_\_\_\_\_\_ - How do we grow in holiness.

**Hebrews 12:14 (ESV) Strive** for peace with everyone, and for **holiness** without which no one will **see** the Lord. Reference: 1 Peter 1:15

Perfecting Holiness: Seeing sin as God sees sin

- a) Separating from the world (closeness)
- b) Living in obedience (character)
- c) Confessing your sins (purity and perfection)

**2 Corinthians 6:17.** Therefore, **come out** from among unbelievers, and separate yourselves from them, says the Lord. Don't touch their filthy things, and I will welcome you. **v.18.** And I will be your Father, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."
