I Thessalonians 4:3. God's will is for you to be holy, so stay away from all sexual sin. **4.** Then each of you will control his own body and live in holiness and honor-**5.** not in lustful passion like the pagans who do not know God and his ways.

Introduction: We're in our series, the "Seven Deadly Sins". We've discussed overcoming pride, envy, anger, gluttony, greed, and last week we discussed overcoming slothfulness. Today, we will discuss *Overcoming Lust - Sexual Sins*.

Review: Seven Deadly Sins

- 1. Overcome pride by humility
- 2. Overcome envy by contentment (inward fulfilment)
- 3. Overcome anger by self-control (restraint of the will)
- 4. Overcome gluttony by diet (kosher) and portions
- 5. Overcome greed by generosity
- 6. Overcome slothfulness by work

What is Sex? The fundamental meaning: Sex is the intercourse of the genitalia of a male and female. – Genesis 2:24

What sex is not:

Sex is not love - Sex can be used as an expression of love, but sex is not the proof love exists in a relationship.

Sex is not spiritual - You don't grow spiritually after having sex. There is no marriage in heaven; then, there is no sex in heaven either (see Matthew 22:30).

Sex is not oral, anal, same gender or masturbation – these acts are not fundamentally definition of biblical sex. You have to have the two genitalia of a male and female uniting as one.

What sex is:

Sex is sensual (appetite of our flesh) - Our spirit does not get horny, our flesh does.

Sex is sacred - God made sex good and put boundaries around it for marriage only. (Hebrews 13:4)

Purpose of sex:

1. Consummation of the marriage covenant (unites our flesh as one)

2. Conceive children

3. Confirm the marriage covenant - Sex releases the bonding chemicals of oxytocin and vasopressin

Casual sex - God does not endorse *casual sex* (sex outside of marriage) because it unites your soul and body with multiple lives, not just one, which binds your soul to other souls before marriage.

How we overcome lust and sexual sins:

1. Walk in the _____

Galatians 5:16. So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your **sinful nature** craves. Galatians 5:19-21

"We're called to walk in the spirituality, not sensuality."

2. Remove yourself from _____

I Thessalonians 4:3. God's will is for you to be holy, so stay away from all sexual sin. 4. Then each of you will control his own body and live in holiness and honor. Reference: 1 Corinthians 6:18-20, 15-17

3. Get _____

I Corinthians 7:1. Now concerning the things of which you wrote to me: It is good for a man not to touch a woman. 2. Nevertheless, because of sexual immorality, let each man have his own wife and let each woman have her own husband. 3. Let the husband render to his wife the affections due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. 8. But I say to the unmarried and to the widows: It is good for them if they remain even as I am; 9. but if they cannot exercise self-control, let them marry. For it is better to marry than to burn with passion. (NKJV)
