## I Thessalonians 4:4-6

- ➤ We once lived in our lustful **passions** "sexual sins"
- We were like the pagans "did not know God"
- We now live in **purity** "we live holy unto God"

## **Sexual Relationships:**

- Defined by the two shall "become one genitalia" All other acts of sex are not defined by this term of sex between a man & a woman.
- Restricted to "marriage only."
- Sex before marriage is called "sexual immorality."

**Hebrews 13:4**. Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but **fornicators** and **adulterers** God will judge. (NKJV)

## **Overcome Sexual Immorality**

- 1. Walk in the Spirit separates you from your sexual cravings
- 2. Stay Away avoid things that awaken your sexual nature
- 3. Get Married this solves the sexual temptations

Introduction: God and Government – Romans 13:1-2

- Government is instituted by God v1a. "all authority comes from God"
- Politicians have been placed in office sovereignly by God v1b. "those in positions of authority have been placed there by God"
- Rebellion against government is rebellion against God v.2. "anyone who rebels against authority is rebelling against what God has instituted"
