2. Spiritual Words with Spiritual People - 1 Corinthians 2:13-15

Example: Jesus and Disciples – John 6:56-69 (NLT)

Identity Gospel – Christ followers become divided by preaching a gospel that identifies Christ in a bias way concerning divisive cultural issues such as race, politics, social justice, etc.

"We want to be a **spiritually awakened** church not a **racially**, **socially** or **politically** woken church."

We're talking about being **spiritually** woke, so we can know what to do **racially**, **politically** and **socially** in such a time as this to **connect** the world to Christ.

"My Kingdom is not an earthly kingdom. If it were, my followers would fight to keep me from being handed over to the Jewish leaders. But my Kingdom is not of this world." John 18:36(NLT)

Example: Politics - Jesus and Caesar (Taxes) - Mark 12:15-17

3. The Awakening – "We're going back to the basics!"

What puts us into a deep sleep: Mark 4:18-19

- a) Cares of this world
- b) Comforts of this world

c) Contentment with this world		
a) Proclaim the This is the consistent, unchangeable, and constant message of the church		
Mark 16:15. "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation."		
"You center your life around the events of the gospel (Christ's death, burial and resurrection)."		
2 Corinthians 2:15 . He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will love for Christ, who died and was raised for them. (NLT)		
b) Make This is the consistent, unchangeable, and constant ministry of the church – didn't say go vote!		
Matthew 28:18-20, Romans 8:29 • Mission – "Go make disciples of all nations" • Membership – "baptize them" • Maturity – "teach them to obey the commands I have given you"		
 We live by faith. "We teach Christ will not only make your life better but make you become Christlike. "The best life you can live now is arranging your life around following Christ." 		
 We teach <u>apologetics</u>. We need to know how to defend our faith against those who oppose Christ and have the ability explain to the salvation of Christ for those who seeking. 1 Peter 3:15 		
c) the time – This is the consistent, unchangeable, and constant mindfulness of the church to know God's time, by the events and the seasons .		
Seven Feast of Israel Events and Seasons		
Spring Season – First coming of Christ		
1. Passover (April) – Death of Christ		

Fall Season – Second coming of Christ

5. Trumpets – Rapture of the church (September)

2. Unleavened Bread (April) –Sinlessness of Christ 3. Firstfruits – (April) Resurrection of Christ

4. Pentecost – (May/June) Holy Spirit of Christ/Church

6. Atonement – Christ returns to Israel (September/October)

7. Tabernacles – Kingdom age of Christ
