Message: The Invitation

Text:



Mark 1:14. Later on, after John was arrested, Jesus went into Galilee, where he preached God's Good News. **15.** "The time promised by God has come at last!" he announced. "The **Kingdom** of God is near! **Repent** of your sins and **believe** the Good News (Gospel)!"

- **16.** One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw **Simon** and his brother **Andrew** throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living. **17.** Jesus **called out** to them, "**Come**, **follow** me, and I will show you how to **fish for people!**" **18.** And they left their nets at once and followed him.
- **19.** A little farther up the shore Jesus saw **Zebedee's sons**, **James** and **John**, in a boat repairing their nets. He **called them** at once, and they also followed him, leaving their father, **Zebedee**, in the boat with the hired men. (NLT)

Talk:

Our text talks about Jesus beginning His ministry and inviting **ordinary** people to **follow** Him, so they can do **extraordinary** things **through** Him. It's through our text that we will cover:

- **Call** they were invited
- Conviction they repented and believed the gospel
- Commitment they left all and followed Him
- 1. The Call v17. Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" 18. And they left their nets at once and followed him.

Anointing – Holy Spirit: 1 John 2:20. But you have been **anointed** by the Holy One, and you have all knowledge. ESV

Wrap up: You've been called by His Spirit because you have been chosen, appointed, and anointed.

- 2. The **Conviction v.15.** "The time promised by God has come at last!" he announced. "The **Kingdom** of God is near! **Repent** of your sins and **believe** the Good News (Gospel)!"
 - a) Convinced sinner
 - b) Repent one time for sin
 - c) continual trust in the gospel

Acts 20:21. I have had one message for Jews and Greeks alike-the necessity of repenting from sin and turning to God, and of having faith in our Lord Jesus. (NLT)

- a) Repent from sin
- b) Turn to God
- c) Have faith in our Lord Jesus

Reference: 2 Corinthians 7:10

Wrap up: You've been convicted by His Spirit and became convinced you're a sinner, repented, and believe in Christ.

- 3. The **Commitment** v18. they left their nets at once and followed v.19. Him He **called them** at once, and they also followed him, leaving their father, Zebedee, in the boat with the hired men.
 - a) exchange your life for His life
 - b) Blessings leaving all on earth
 - c) Rewards finished works

Exchange: 2 Corinthians 5:15. He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will **no longer live for themselves**. Instead, they will **live for Christ**, who died and was raised for them. (NLT)
