- 1. Discuss the following passage from the message; "Your witness and the gospel go together when it comes to connecting people with Christ to become Christ followers" (Acts 1:8)
- 2. Share your testimony:

 - B) How has your life radically changed since following Christ?
 - C) How did Christ reveal Himself to you?
- 3. How often do you share your personal testimony with non-believers?

- 4. Do you feel comfortable sharing your testimony with non-believers? Why or why not?
- 5. If you are not comfortable, what actions would it take for you to be comfortable?
- 6. Your testimony should be PROVEN the testimony of your lifestyle B.C. (before Christ) and A.C. (after Christ) must be consistent to validate the truthfulness of your testimony.
