Service of Elders: oversee the flock of God (Acts 20:28):

1) Care – you teach, lay hands on the sick, counsel, pray, make sure no one is left alone, etc.

- 3) Cover you promote, preserve, and protect the institution of the church you live the faith, and defend the faith.

Mark 16:15. (ESV) And he said to them, "God into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.

References: 2 Corinthians 5:21, I Corinthians 15:3-4

Gospel exclusive – "There is only one way to God (Jesus) but there are many ways to faith in Christ."

**John 14:6. (NLT)** Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me."

Gospel relevance: "How does the gospel apply to the human experience?"

Romans 3:23-24. (NLT) For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. Yet God freely and graciously declares that we are righteous. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty of sin.

"You have **one message** that all your messages **originate** from the gospel – Christ crucified."

Acts 20:21. (NLT) I have had one message for Jews and Greeks alike-the necessity of repenting from sin and turning to God, and of having faith in our Lord Jesus.

Christ-centered life: Galatians 2:20. (NLT) My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So, I live in in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
