TEXT:



2 Corinthians 5:19. (NLT) For God was **in Christ**, **reconciling** the world to himself, no longer **counting** people's **sins against them**. And he gave us this this wonderful **message of reconciliation**.

2 Corinthians 5:21. (NLT) For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

TALK: Post Resurrection - Reconciliation

Introduction:

- The resurrection of Christ is the foundation our Christian doctrine stands upon. Reference: 1 Corinthians 15:17
- Christ and the Cross "Christ's work on the cross" References: John 19:30, 2 Corinthians 5:19, 21
 - God **closed** our sin account
 - God reconciled us to Himself
 - God made us right in Christ

Points: Post Resurrection - "Identity in Christ - Sit ... Walk ... Stand"

PT 1. _____ with Christ in the heavenly realm.

"You're **seated** with Christ the heavenly realm in the **position** of **honor** and authority." (Rest).

Ephesians 2:6. (NLT) For he **raised us** from **dead** along with Christ and **seated us** with him in the **heavenly realm** because we are **united** with Christ Jesus.

References: Colossians 2:10, Genesis 2:1-2, Matthew 11:28-29

Principle: God finishes His works and we rest in those works.

"If you're feeling more **stress** than **rest** following Christ, you're living by **religious obligations** instead of the finished works of Christ." **PK**

PT 2. _____ by faith in Christ on earth.

"You walk in the finished works of Christ by faith."

2 Corinthians 5:7. (ESV) for we walk by faith, not by sight.

References: Galatians 2:20, Ephesians 2:8-10, Hebrews 4:1-2

"You enter God's **rest** by having **faith** in God's **finished works** of **salvation** and **reconciliation** by Jesus Christ."

Example: Christ's works of reconciliation:

- God is **holy** and Jesus is our means of holiness
- > God is **righteous** and Jesus is our means of righteousness
- > God is **power** and Jesus is our means of power
- God is _____ and Jesus is my means of _____

PT 3. _____ against demonic forces.

"If you're **not seated** with Christ and **walking by faith** you will not be able to **stand** against the evil one."

I Peter 5:8. (NLT) Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. **9a. Stand firm** against him and be **strong** in the **faith**.

"You stand in **victory over** the **devil** and the **temptations** of your **flesh** from your **seated** position in the **heavenly** realm with Christ."
