Points to the Message: Ministers of Reconciliation

Introduction

> You were **saved** to be **equipped** to do God's work.

Ephesians 4:11. Now these are the **gifts** Christ **gave** to the **church**: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the **pastors** and **teachers**. **12.** Their **responsibility** is to **equip** God's people to do his **work** and **build** up the church, the **body** of Christ. (NLT)

"The **secret** of being like Christ is **walking** in the **steps** of Christ." How did Christ order His life after God?" Ephesians 2:10

1. The minister's motivation - "Christ's love for us."

v14. Either way, Christ's love controls us. Since we believe that Christ died for all, we also believe that we have all died to our old life.

v15. He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them.

"Christ's love makes you so grateful that it compels you to live for Him instead of yourself."

"God desires a relationship based on love, not rules and regulations."

2. The minister's makeover - "A new person in Christ"

v16. So we have stopped **evaluating** others from a **human point** of view. At one time we thought of Christ merely from a human point of view. How differently we know him now! **v17.** This means that anyone who **belongs** to Christ has become a **new person**. The **old life** is gone; a **new life** has begun!

"We no longer look at people by their outward appearance, but we want to know if they know Christ, so they can experience a spiritual makeover in Christ."



3. The minister's ministry - "reconciling people to God"

v18. And all of this is a **gift** from **God**, who brought us **back to himself** through **Christ**. And God has given us this **task** of **reconciling people** to him.

"God has given us the ministry of reconciling people to Himself."

4. The minister's message - "Come back to God!"

v19. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. v20. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" v21. For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

"Come back to God! He no longer holds our sins against us. God made us right with Himself in Christ."

Takeaway: "We're ministers of reconciliation, reconciling the world to God and to one another through the ministry of reconciliation."

Application – Mind Transformation

1. What is your **primary** motivation for following Christ? If you lack motivation in your relationship with Christ and His works, why?

2. What is **new about your life** since you received Christ? Do you remember the experience of uniting with Christ and becoming a new person?

3. How do you evaluate people of different races, status, politics, education, etc.? Do you see people like God sees people – need to reconcile in Christ?

4. When was the last time you reconciled someone to God? How do you make your **appeal** to the lost about reconciling with God?

5. How are you going to make the **knowledge** of this message a **conviction** within your **mind** to act on?
