Genesis 3:21. Also, for Adam and his wife and the Lord God made **tunics** of **skin** and **clothed** them. **22.** Then the Lord God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil. And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"-

23. therefore the Lord God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken. **24.** So He drove out the man; and He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to quard the way to the tree of life.

Background: Genesis 2:8, 3:1-11

- 1. Freewill of the Soul Genesis 2:8
 - Tree of Life (God's directive)
 - Tree of Knowledge (Human directive)
- 2. Temptation of the Soul Genesis 3:6
 - Good for food v.6 flesh
 - Pleasant to the eves v.6 desires
 - Make wise v.6 pride
- 3. Inverted Soul Genesis 3:6-7
 - Eyes opened (outside)
 - Knew they were naked (inside)
 - Covered themselves

- 4. Hidden Soul Genesis 3:7-11
 - God's call "Where are you"
 - Adam's response "I was naked"
 - God's response "who told you that you were naked"

Fallen Humanity (Lost Image/Status) - Genesis 3:21-24

Points:

- v.21. Also, for Adam and his wife and the Lord God made tunics of skin and clothed them.
 - **Religion** replaces relationship (Laws/Sin/Death)
- v.22. Then the Lord God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil. And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"-
- **v.23.** therefore the Lord God sent **him out** of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.
 - Removed from the sacred space
- **v.24.** So He drove out the man; and He placed **cherubim** at the east of the garden of Eden, and a **flaming sword** which turned every way, to guard the way to the **tree of life**.
 - Resides (exists) in a state of death

Takeaway: Fallen Humanity (Lost Image/Status)

- 1. Religion replaces relationship
- 2. Removed from the sacred space
- 3. Resides in a state of death
