Message: *God's Plan of Redemption*

Scripture: Ephesians 1:9

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Review:

1. Creation of Heavenly Beings
2. Creation of Human Beings
3. Fall of Human Beings

Keywords: "If you can't define it, you can't fulfill it."

1. Heavenly realm – God and angels dwelling (invisible)
2. Earthly realm – Humans dwelling (visible)
3. Heavenly and Earthly realms – interaction between the two
4. Human beings – made spirit, soul, and body (trichotomy)
 - **spirit** – communes with God
 - **soul** – awareness/mind, emotions, and desires
 - **body** – connects with physical (senses/sensual)
5. Sacred space – place of God's presence
6. Assembly – God's gatherings
7. Presence – God makes Himself known

Message: *God's Redemption Plan*

Redemption – the actions taken to regain something lost

Redemption Plan: At the 'right time' he will bring everything together under the authority of **Christ** - everything in **heaven** and on **earth**.

Critical Thinking: Where has God established the authority of Christ on earth, so I can get in alignment with His authority, Ephesians 1:22-23?

Points to the Message:

 - a) God's judgement – Genesis 6:7
 - b) Noah's favor – Genesis 6:8
 - c) Noah's Sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth
 - d) Idolatry and judgment – Genesis 11:1-10

2. Abraham and Promise – Genesis 12:1-3

- a) Land – Sacred space
- b) Nation – God’s chosen people
- c) Name – Great/Famous
- d) Purpose – In you all the families of the earth shall be blessed

3. Moses and Israel – Exodus 3-4

- a) Call of Moses – Exodus 3-4, 19:4
- b) Sanctuary and Presence - Exodus 25:8, 40:34
 - Outer court
 - Holy Place
 - Holiest of Holies
- c) Priesthood and Worship – Exodus 40:12, 14-15

“God of details – gave instructions to the priest, and on how to observe God’s laws and His sacrificial system.”

- 1) Tabernacle/Titles/Treasures (sacrifices)
 - 2) Seven Feasts – Leviticus 23 (reenactments)
 - 3) Sacrificial System – voluntary/mandatory
- d) God’s Holy People: Leviticus 18:1-4, Exodus 24:7, Deuteronomy 32:8-9

Critical Thinking (C.T.): “If you can’t define it, you can’t fulfill it.”

3. How do I recognize Satan’s war against God in our American culture, Ephesians 6:10-12? What am I doing about it?

5. How does being separated from God in any areas of my life affect my **beliefs** and **behavior**, Romans 1:18-32?
