Use the message and the message notes and message help guide your answers and discussion for group.

Pre-Discussion Questions:

- 1. "God does not allow sin to dwell where He abides." God and sin can not exist in the same space. What does this mean for a someone who is a Christ Follower, and continues to sin without conviction?
- 2. God's eternal plan is to redeem humans and bring them all back under His authority. What will this look like?

Discussion Questions:

- 3. How do we recognize God's presence in our life and in the lives of others?
- 4. Can we mistake God's presence in people's lives with human performance?
- 5. Explain and discuss the following quote: "Within ourselves we cannot know God's ways, He must reveal Himself and His ways to us." How does God reveal His ways to us?
- 6. Moses did not receive the blessings of God until he submitted to go where God told him to go. As Christ Followers we must fully submit ourselves to see the ways of God and get the blessings of God. What does a life fully submitted to God look like? (Psalms 103:7)
- 7. As Christ Followers we know what the word says about living a submitted life unto Christ and yet we struggle with doing so. What prevents us from living a life fully submitted to God?
