Pre-Discussion Questions:

- 1. What did the Holy Spirit reveal to you in Sunday's message?
- 2. Please share your salvation story with the group. (At what age did you start to follow Christ? Who led you to Christ? Why did you make the decision to follow Christ?)
- 3. What was your life like before Christ, and how did it change after?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read and discuss John 3:3-8
 - a. How does Jesus explain salvation to Nicodemus? (John 3:8)
- 2. Read and discuss 2 Corinthians 5:17. According to the message and scripture, what does it mean to be a "new creation"?
- 3. What are the four effects of being born again?
- 4. What does it mean to repent? Can you repent without conviction? Why or why not?

What is conviction, and why is conviction an important part of repentance? (2 Corinthians 7:10, Matthew 4:17)
What does it mean to reborn by the spirit?
What does it mean to be dead and now alive in Christ?

 a. What does a dead person look like?
 b. What does a person alive in Christ look like?

Discuss the following point: A disciple of Christ simplifies their life to follow Christ." (Luke 14:33)
