The Message Notes **Message**: *God First Principle* **Text**: Matthew 6:33 (NKJV) Pastor Keith (January 2, 2022)



Matthew 6:33. "But **seek first** the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. **34.** Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble." (NKJV)

Objective: to understand the principle of "first" in our relationship with God and the benefits it brings to our lives.

TALK:

• Christ is teaching on the sermon of the mountain side. He is **deconstructing** to **reconstruct** their faith in God.

Christ teaching on the mountain covered: 1) Beatitudes, 2) Salt and Light, 3) Lust and Adultery, 4) Divorce and Remarriage, and 5) How to pray and How to Fast.

His main phrase is, "You have heard but I say unto you."

- Jesus represents **authority** this means Jesus' teachings were laws that not only **govern** our **beliefs** and **behavior** but return good or bad results on our lives.
- Another one of the many teachings taught on the mountain side was worrying about the necessities of life: food, clothing, and housing. Jesus said the **God** "**First**" Principle takes away your worry.

TEACH:

- 1. First symbolizes your _____ v33. seek first...
 - God is **above** all else
 - All else comes under God's **cover**
 - All else comes into God's order

Luke 14:26. "If you want to be my disciple, you must hate everyone else by comparison - your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters - yes even your own life." (NLT)

Application: The God first principle used as an adjective and put before those things you love make them **belong** to God. God **covers** it and sets it in **order**.

2. First **honors** God's ______ – "seek **first** the **king**dom of God and his **righteousness**..."

- you **obey** God first (flesh)
- you **trust** God first (faith)

Proverbs 3:5-6. Trust in the **Lord** with **all your heart**; do not **depend** on your **own understanding**. **Seek** his will in all you do, and he will **show you** which path to take. (NLT)

Application: Seek God first as your **Lord** and obey Him. Put your trust in God's right way of living, so you can establish the rule and reign of His kingdom on earth.

"**Religion** is man's method of reaching God. The **kingdom** is God's way of bringing heaven to earth."

3. First returns a ______ – "all these **things** (food, clothing, and shelter) will be **added** to you.

- return is based on your faith
- return is proof of God's faithfulness

Luke 6:38. Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full - pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back. (NLT)

Proverbs 3:9-10. Honor the Lord by giving him the first part of all your income, and he will fill your barns with wheat and barley and overflow your wine vats with the finest wines. (Living Bible)

Application: Seek God first principle gives you a return on your obedience and trust in God.

God first principle **covers** your life and **orders** your life, and **returns** to you the promise according to the God first principle.
