The Message Notes Message: In Defense of the Faith – Part II Messenger: Pastor Keith (PK) Text: I Peter 3:14-15 Date: March 6, 2022



Objective: We want to know the answers to questions that are frequently asked about our faith, so we can share the hope we have in Christ.

Review: Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Who created God? **Answer**: The Scriptures teach God **preexisted** and is the **cause** behind creation. (Genesis 1:1)

- God is actual (real)
- God is monotheistic (oneness)
- God is transcendent (otherworldly)

Question: If there is no creator what is the ultimate purpose for your existence?

2. Why do you believe God exists? **Answer**: I believe God exists by the **intelligent** design of the universe, **intricate** design of my body, the **incarnation** of Jesus Christ, and the **impact** of my faith by the gospel."

- a) Intelligent design of the universe. According to Scriptures, God is the designer behind creation. (Romans 1:20, Genesis 1:1-5) God composed order out of chaos by naming distinctions and giving limitations.
- b) Intricate details of my Body. Psalms 139:14-15
- c) _____ of Christ. Colossians 1:15
- d) _____ by faith and the gospel. Romans 10:17, Hebrews 11:6

Question: How do you come to know what you know?

3. Why are we considered sinners? **Answer:** I am a sinner (lawbreaker), by Adam's sin, which spread to each human being. Romans 5:12, Psalms 51:5

Question: Why do humans break God's laws (lawbreakers)?

4. Why are we considered lost? **Answer**: We cannot answer the following questions: Luke 19:10

- a) Where did you come from?
- b) What is the meaning of life?
- c) What happens after death?

5. What is your evidence of the resurrection of Jesus? I Corinthians 15:6-9

Answer:

- a) Jesus died by Roman crucifixion (historians Josephus, Tacitus, and Lucian wrote about it).
- b) Jesus' disciples were **cowards before** the resurrection, and **after** the resurrection, they became **witnesses** and **died for the faith**.
- c) Conversions of Paul, the **persecutor** of the church, became an Apostle and James, the **brother** of Jesus, once a skeptic, became head of the Jerusalem church. (Acts 22:6-21, Acts 15:13-19)
- d) Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were the first eyewitnesses of the resurrection, Matthew 28:1-10. Women testimonies were regarded as worthless and not allowed to testify in a Jewish court of law.

6. Why do you follow Christ? **Answer**: I **follow** Christ because He **loved** me, **died** for me, was **buried**, and **was raised for me.** He **promised me eternal life** with Himself and God. Do you know anyone else better to follow? 2 Corinthians 5:15

7. What are your guiding values? **Answer:** I have a **biblical** worldview. I **defer** to scriptural authority over cultural values, race, ethnicity, etc. Romans 12:2

Biblical worldview: Genesis 1:1-3:9-10

- 1. **Originality** is of God (Genesis 1:1)
- 2. Creativity came from God heaven and earth (Genesis 1:26)
- 3. Identity is in God image and likeness (Genesis 1:26)
- 4. **Sexuality** is defined by God male and female (Genesis 1:27)
- 5. **Activity** comes from God fruitful, multiply, increase, maintain kingdom order over the earth (Genesis 1:28-30)
- 6. Morality is absolute freely eat and shall not eat (Genesis 2:16-17)
- 7. Mortality (death) came from our disobedience (Genesis 2:15-17)
- 8. Unity marriage is between a man and a woman (Genesis 2:24)
- 9. Accountability is to God where are you? (Genesis 3:9-10)
