Introduction: Biblical Marriage

Text: Matthew 19:3-6 **Date:** June 26, 2022



Objective: to **call** us back to the principles (first) of marriage, so we can strengthen our marriages and families for the kingdom, and to be light and salt for the culture.

Matthew 19:3. Some Pharisees came and tried to trap him with this question: "Should a man be allowed to divorce his wife for just any reason?"

Principle: A woman should ask a man, "Where do you live?"

Principle: Sex is sacred, confined for marriage only.

Is marriage by God's **perfect** will or **permissive** will?

Proverbs 18:22. The man who **finds** (happens upon) a wife **finds** a treasure, and he receives favor from the Lord. (NLT) Genesis 2:22-23

Principle: You marry by **revelation** and not **reason**. I Corinthians 7:10

Stages of Human Love to Heavenly Love for Marriage:	
Stage 1.	(attraction) - <u>Falling</u> in Love Type of love: <u>Eros</u> a passion that is impulsive and irrational which takes control of your emotions and mind. Type of feelings: adrenaline, lustful, euphoria, giddy, etc. Type of chemicals: testosterone (men), estrogen (women), norepinephrine, dopamine, oxytocin Type of interests: egocentric and sexual Outcome : relationship is egocentric . Couple is driven by self-interests and romanticism which fuels the passion of sensuality in the relationship.
Stage 2.	(affection) – <u>Being</u> in Love Type of love: <u>Philia</u> – a bonding that develops a friendship through mutual interests, trust, and transparency. Type of feelings: acceptance, affirmation, approval, support, security, and closeness Type of chemicals: dopamine, serotonin, oxytocin, endorphins, vasopressin Type of interests: mutually balanced Outcome : relationship is transactional . Couple is driven by mutual benefits, compatibility, and closeness of the relationship that has become a bond beyond sex.
Stage 3.	(attachment) - <u>Staying</u> in Love – Genesis 2:23 Type of love: <u>Pragma</u> - commitment, and long-term interests Type of feelings: acceptance, affirmation, approval, support, security, and closeness Type of chemicals: dopamine, serotonin, oxytocin, endorphins, vasopressin, cortisol Type of interests: egocentric and mutually beneficial Outcome: relationship is exclusive. Couple is driven by feeling a part of each other (match) and want to commit to one-to-one relationship.
Stage 4.	[agape] – <u>Unfailing</u> Love - highest form of love Type of love: <u>Spiritual</u> – Romans 5:5 Type of feelings: act of the will – John 15:12 Type of interests: sacrificial – I John 3:16 Type of chemicals: all chemicals (emotions) are under the subjection Outcome : relationship is sacrificial . Couple is driven by their command to love each other just like Christ loves them, so they serve one another sacrificially in marriage as husband and wife
