Helpful Hints:

- Try not to start your answer with "I think...". Instead ask "What does God's word say about this?" Always refer to the word of God, which is the answer to every question.
- If no one knows the answer, it is okay to say, "I don't know". Do some studying before the next meeting and be ready to share your answers.

<u>Objective of message:</u> to teach how the life of Christ and His authority flows through us by applying the cross in our daily walk with Christ.

1.	a. What is the self-life, and how is it contrary to a true relationship with Christ? (Luke 9:23)
2.	Read and explain the following quote: "Self will gladly worship a God that will esteem their desires, worth, fulfillment, and happiness."
3.	How can a Christ Follower make their relationship about themselves instead of Christ?
4.	"Self not sin is God's greatest enemy", what does this quote mean?
5.	Share a time when you recognize your self interest over the will and way of Christ?
6.	"We can believe Christ died for us, but we have trouble believing we died too." This is called co-crucifixion. What does it mean to die with Christ?
7.	What does a self-less life in Christ look like? Explain practical day to day application (Galatians 2:20) a. How does a Christ Follower know they are truly following God selflessly with no personal agenda or interest?
8.	What did you learn from Sunday's message that you will immediately apply to your life?
