I Peter 1:15. But as He who called you is holy you also be holy in all your conduct, **16**. Because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

Objective: to **know** God is **Holy** and how to live a **holy** lifestyle according to God's **covenant** that **honors** Him.

Points of Message:

1. Positional holiness – "He who called you is holy."

- An inherit attribute
- Pure (sinless) and perfect (complete)
- Transcendent from creation

I Corinthians 1:2. I am writing to God's church in Corinth, to you who have been called by God to be his own holy people. He made you holy by means of Christ Jesus, just as he did for all people everywhere who call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, their Lord and ours. (NLT)

- Called by God "to be his own holy people"
- Made you holy "by means of Christ Jesus"
- Who "people everywhere who call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

2. Practicing holiness – v.15 He who called you is holy you also be holy in all your conduct.

"To **be holy** does not refer to your own nature. It refers to God's **nature** and our **conformity** to His nature by obeying His **moral precepts** that makes us **distinct** from the sinfulness in this world."

How We Practice Holiness:

a) Submission: I Peter 1:14. as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance. Reference: Leviticus 20:8

b) Separation: 2 Corinthians 6:17. Therefore, come out from among **unbelievers**, and **separate** yourselves from them, says the Lord. **Don't touch** their **filthy** things, and I will welcome you. (NLT) Reference: Exodus 23:32-33

c) Sanctification: John 17:15. I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. 16. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. 17. Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. (ESV)

d) Sexual purity: I Thessalonians 4:3. God's will is for you to be holy, so stay from all sexual sin. 4. Then each of you will control his own body and live holiness and honor- 5. not in lustful passion like the pagans (unbelievers) who do not know God and his ways. (NLT)

e) Sacrifice: Romans 12:1. And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living holy sacrifice-the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.

3. Perfecting holiness - v16. "Be holy for I am holy."

Hebrews 10:14. For by that one offering he forever made **perfect** those who are **being made holy**. (NLT)

How We Perfect Holiness:

a) Do not Sin: I John 2:1. My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus, the one who is truly righteous. (NLT)

b) Bear Fruit: John 15:4. Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me. (NLT).

Galatians 5:22. But the **Holy Spirit produces** this kind of **fruit** in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23**. Gentleness, and self-control.

c) Transformed Mind: Romans 12:2. Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect. (NLT)

d) Grace Teaching: Titus 2:11. For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men 12. Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age. (NKJV)

- **Devotion** grace of God that brings salvation to us
- Discipline teachings to deny ungodliness and worldly lust
- **Development** we should live soberly (self-control), righteously (right way), and godly (like God) in this present age
