Objective: to understand our salvation in Christ comes along with doing good works to accomplish God's eternal plan.

Principle: The way we see our identity in Christ is the way we follow Christ and do good works.

Application: Our **identity** in Christ, along with the Scriptures, will continually confront our character, race, gender, status, and the values of our culture.
