**Text: 2 Corinthians 5:17**. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

**Objective**: to teach we're **spiritual** beings with a **nature** made in the **image** of Christ (identity).

## **Review: Our Original Identity**

Identity: a set of characteristics you use to identify yourself.

**Genesis 1:27**. So, **God** created **man** in His **own image**; in the **image** of God, He created him; **male** and **female** He created them.

1. <u>Original</u> Identity: We were created **spiritual beings** made after the **image** of God that possess a **soul**, which lives in a **body**, Genesis 1:27, 2:7.

**P&P** - Do I see my identity as being like God?

2. <u>Fallen</u> Identity: We're **born** with a **sin nature**.

**Psalms 51:5.** For I was **born a sinner**-yes, from the moment my mother **conceived** me. (NLT)

We're **dead** spiritually, and our **self-image** is exalted. Whatever we **imagine** and whatever our **fleshly appetites crave**, that is what we're **becoming**.

3. <u>Crisis</u>: The culture has forsaken God. Reference: Romans 1:23-24

The culture worships self. Your identity is whatever your **debased** soul can **imagine** and your fleshly appetites **desire**.

## Fallen: Nature versus Nurture:

- Nature: inborn sin
- Nurture: self-exaltation
- Normalize: your authentic self is your identity. So, there is no need to repent for your behavior.

## **Cultural Identity Crisis:**

- Who am I? I am my authentic self.
- What am I? Whatever I can **imagine**.
