⁴ You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God. ⁵ Do you think the Scriptures have no meaning? They say that God is passionate that the spirit he has placed within us should be faithful to him. ⁶ And he gives grace generously. As the Scriptures say, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. ⁷ So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Objective: Our objective is to encourage believers to stand their ground and not give in to the enemy when facing challenges as they strive to live a life of holiness.

To make the devil flee, we must first humble ourselves before God.

- 1. Verse 7 ... *Humble yourselves before God*.
 - a. to God Philippians 2:5-8 ⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. ⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, ⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross.
 - b. ______ for God Romans 12:1 And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.
 - c. <u>God</u> John 12:26 If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him."

Once we've humbled ourselves, we are then able to resist the devil.
