Reference Scripture: Genesis 2:18, 21-24 (NKJV)

- If no one knows the answer, it is okay to say, "I don't know". Do some studying before the next meeting and be ready to share your answers.

- 1. What did the Holy Spirit reveal to you from Sunday's message?
- 2. Briefly share your first memories of a positive female role model in your life.
