<u>Reference Scripture:</u> *Proverbs 13:22. Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner's wealth passes to the godly. (NLT)*

Helpful Hints:

- Try not to start your answer with "I think...". Instead ask "What does God's word say about this?" Always refer to the word of God, which is the answer to every question.
- If no one knows the answer, it is okay to say, "I don't know". Do some studying before the next meeting and be ready to share your answers.

- 7. Where you raised in a household where Godliness was more important than goodness? If so, please share. What did you learn in your household that you still use today?
- 8. How can someone that was not raised in a Godly household learn to raise Godly children?
- 9. Whether you have children or not, what is the legacy you are working on creating and leaving?
