John 10:1. "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber. **2.** But he who enters by the door is the sheepherd of the sheep.

3. To him the gatekeeper opens. The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. 4. When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. 5. A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers."

v16. "And I have **other sheep** that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So, there will be one flock, one shepherd."

v27. "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. 28. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand." (ESV)
