Text: Matthew 7:7 (NLT)



Matthew 7:7. Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you.

Objective : To encourage Christ-followers to place a premium on pursuing and developing a personal relationship with God (<i>through Christ</i>) and others.
What was the biggest prayer request you ever made to God? What do you do in the waiting period?
Points to the Message: 1. To receive, it's okay to Matthew 7:7a
a. Are you asking with the right <u>motive</u> ? James 4:3
b. Be persistent with your plea (<i>petition</i>). Proverbs 24:16a (KJV); Luke 18:4-5
Does God get tired of me asking? Are there any limitations when we talk to God?
c. Do you know there's ataking place? Daniel 10:12-14 NLT
How long should one pray about a situation? Can heaven hear your prayers? 1 Thessalonians 5:16
2. You will find, if you keep on <u>seeking</u> . Matthew 7:7b
Seeking involves asking, plus action. James 2:17
When was the last time you sought (past-tense) the Lord? Where are you in your personal journey seeking (present-tense) His face? Psalm 105:4

a. Make Him a <u>priority</u> ! Matthew 6:33; Isaiah 55:6; James 4:8
How do we seek God? Ask yourself, how bad do you need Him?
b. What are some practical ways you can start seeking God first ? Proverbs 8:17
 Start your day with prayer Read something and try to memorize a verse for the week. (Psalm 119:11) Play back the Sermon Journal
5. Take every struggle to God6. Corporate Prayer & Worship (Hebrews 10:25)
3 requires action (faith) on our part that opens the door Matthew 7:7c
Knocking can be considered importunity (describes a plea that is so persistent or demanding that it becomes annoying). Luke 11:5-8
How far would you go for a friend? Are you willing to risk being denied?
Do you have a willingness to be a blessing to others or do you see assisting others a hassle?
