Series: Hearing God's Voice Message: Following Jesus and His Teachings Messenger: Pastor Keith Text: Mark 1:17-18, John 8:23 Date: August 27, 2023



John 8:23. He said to them, "You are from **below**; I am from **above**. You are of this world; I am **not** of this world."

Mark 1:17. And Jesus said to them, "follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men." **18.** And immediately they left their nets and followed him. (ESV)

Objective: to comprehend what it means hearing the call to follow Jesus and His teachings from the 2^{nd} dimension.

Review

1. <u>Hearing</u> God's voice. It's like sheep **knowing** the Shepherd's voice and **following** Him. (John 10:3-27)

2. <u>Listening</u> to God's voice. You enter God's House to **listen** to God's word, so you can **learn** to **fear** Him. (Ecclesiastes 5:1)

3. <u>Knowing</u> God's natural voice. God speaks to us **indirectly** through various human vessels to convey His words to us. (I Thessalonians 2:13)

4. <u>Opening</u> the door to God's voice. We **zealously repent** to let Christ in our souls by **confessing** we **no longer live** but **Christ lives in us** by **trusting** in Him. (Revelations 3:14-22)

5. <u>Confirming</u> God's voice. We confirm God is speaking to us by 1) Spirit to **spirit**, 2) the **Scriptures**, 3) **evaluation** by church leaders, 4) it **matches** our calling and gifts, and 5) it **glorifies** God. (I Corinthians 10:31)

6. Praving to hear God's direction: Proverbs 3:5-6:

- Trust in (who)
- the Lord (how)
- with **all** your **heart** (in what way)
- do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him (why)
- he will make your **paths straight**.

Takeaway: If you trust God with all your heart, you won't lean on your own understanding. If you don't lean on your understanding, you will submit to God. If you submit to God, He will direct your paths. If God directs your paths, you can trust that direction with all your heart.

4. What stage are you in the process of discipleship?

5. When you are reading the Scriptures, are you following Jesus' teachings and being discipled by Him?
