**Objective**: Our objective is to teach the importance and benefits of dwelling together in unity as the body of Christ.

(ESV) Ephesians 4:1-6: I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, <sup>2</sup> with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, <sup>3</sup> eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. <sup>4</sup> There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— <sup>5</sup> one Lord, one faith, one baptism, <sup>6</sup> one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

What is Unity?
Biblical unity is a group of Christ Followers, connected by the Holy Spirit, all with one purpose, and that is to advance the kingdom of God and glorify Christ.
"Pando" – Latin for
