Text: Matthew 16:24. Then Jesus said to his disciples, “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. **25.** For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it. **26.** What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeit his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? (NIV)
