Hebrews 4:11. Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, so that no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience. **12.** For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. **13.** And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account. (ESV)
