Acts 4:32. Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. 33. And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. 34. Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, 35. And laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

Review:

Point to Ponder: You're called not only to **believe** in Christ but **belong** in comm**unity** with the Body of Christ, the church. **Question to consider**: What action should you take to belong to a community? **Study verses**: Romans 12.4-5

Point to Ponder: We're building our community in Christ by putting into practice, being united in covenant, sharing in communion, and obeying our constitution. **Question to consider**: What action should you take to help us build our community? **Study verse**: Exodus 24:7

Point to Ponder: We unify as a Body when we S.I.T. (spend intentional time together in community groups). **Question to consider**: Are you in a community group? If not, why? **Verses to remember**: Acts 2.42-47

Point to Ponder: We practice being community in excellence. **Question to consider**: Do you walk in the traits of the Spirit of excellence? If not, why? **Study verses**: Matthew 25.21-30

Message - Community in Giving

Point to Ponder: Our model for giving is (1) agreement, (2) other person centered, (3) fellowship – joint sharing, and (4) distribution. **Question to consider**: Are you in agreement with our model for giving? If not, why? **Study verses**: Acts 4.32-34

Point to Ponder: Our motivation for giving is gratitude. **Question to consider**: Do you give out of gratitude or out of obligation? **Study verse**: 2 Corinthians 8.9

Point to Ponder: We give *first*, to *honor* God in worship and *second*, to *support* our prosperity plan, so we can enrich our community in Christ to cover the financial needs of our community. **Question to consider**: Do I support the prosperity plan? **Study verse**: Acts 4.32

Point to Ponder: You set aside the **first portion** of your income according to how God has blessed you and according to your agreement to support our prosperity plan. **Question to consider**: How do I support the prosperity plan? **Study verses**: I Corinthians 16.1-2

Point to Ponder: Most followers are unable to give a tithe because before they came to Christ, they used their attitude toward money as more worldly than godly. **Question to consider**: What is my attitude toward money? **Study verse**: Matt. 6:24

If the requirements of bringing tithes were *required* and *honorable* under the Law, then how much more should those under God's grace meet or exceed the *set amount* of a tithe *out of gratitude and generosity*.

Takeaway: We envision building our community in Christ by practicing giving with an attitude of gratitude, giving, freely, liberally, and cheerfully, so we can first honor God, and second to support our prosperity plan to enrich our community.
