**Objective:** Am I saved? We want to *explore* what it means to have a *spiritual* awakening in Christ.

Revi	ew: Our Salvation in Christ (Acts 4.12)
1.	$\underline{\hspace{1cm}} Sin - Romans \ 3.23. \ For \ everyone \ has \ sinned, \ we \ all \ fall \ short of God's glorious standard.$
2.	Salvation – the belief that through Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection, humanity can be forgiven for their sins, reconciled to God, and receive eternal life. (Romans 1.16)
3.	The three steps of Christ's Salvation:
a)	of Sin (John 16.8) – <i>hearing</i> the gospel, the Holy Spirit <i>convicts</i> you of sin, <i>leading</i> to <i>godly sorrow</i> , and <i>returning</i> to God through Jesus Christ (2 Corinthians 7.10).
b)	Christ (Romans 10.9-10) - you <i>believe</i> in your <i>heart</i> and <i>confess</i> with your mouth that Christ is <i>Lord,</i> you are baptized to <i>identify</i> with Him, marking the start of your journey in Him, and your unity with His Body, the Church.
c)	in Christ (Titus 3.5) – you have been <i>cleansed</i> from your sins and made <i>new by the Holy Spirit</i> , giving you a new nature, and a new desire to live according to God's will.
