Text: I Thessalonians 5.16-18 (NKJV)



In Christ, you walk in the Spirit by: (1) setting your mind on things above, not on earth, (2) walking by faith, not by sight, and (3) internalizing God's Word to change the way you think (new mind).

Reflection: What is the evidence that you practice walking in the Spirit?	
Servants of Christ are set-apart, as living sacrifices, wholly devoted to serving God in a way that is acceptable worship to Him. They look forward to the day when they will be rewarded for their faithful service and enter into the joy of the Lord, being united with Christ at the Wedding Feast - the ultimate celebration of salvation References: Matthew 22.1-14, Revelation 19.6-9	
Reflection: What are some signs that you are God's servant?	
Three Essentials for Unceasing Prayer:	
1 of prayer – Matthew 6.9-10 (NIV):	
v9a. 'Our Father in heaven' (relationship) v9b. 'hallowed be your name' (reverence) v10. 'your kingdom come your will be done on earth as it is in heaven' (submission)	

Commentary: Our Father states God's accessibility to us as family members. His name makes Him worthy of worshipping. Asking for His kingdom to come is our commitment to obeying God's will and living in a way that our actions reflect His reign on earth, just as it is in heaven.

Posture of prayer *reflects* reverence for God as our Father, seeking His kingdom to come, and aligning our desire to obey His will on earth as it is in heaven.
