Message: Warning to Compromised Followers - 'I never knew you.'

Scripture: Matthew 7.21-23 (NKJV)



**Objective**: Jesus is teaching His disciples about being genuine followers. Our teaching will center on not being *compromised* followers of Christ.

Context: verses 13-20 – Jesus talks about the gate that is an entry into the kingdom and identifying false prophets. Jesus referenced two paths to take in life – verses 13-14: a) gate: it's hard to enter, the way is difficult, and few find it – but it leads to life. - Self-denial lifestyle - you reject this life and pick up the cross and follow Christ as Lord. gate: it's easy to enter, the path is broad, and many go through b) it - but it leads to destruction. Indulgent lifestyle - you place your desires above the cross and Jesus's Lordship. 2. False prophets are known by their followers do not outright reject following Christ, but 3. they comingle godliness and worldliness. **Reflection:** Which path are you walking and the cost to follow that path? **Discussion**: How do you discern the prophet (pastor) in your life? Action to take: Examine one area where your lifestyle may be drifting toward the wide gate and not the narrow path. Message Points: \_\_\_\_\_ talk: v.21. 'Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord' 1. shall enter into the kingdom of heaven – Reference Matthew 15.8

**Reflection:** Do I profess Christ or possess Christ?

**Discussion:** Why do you think Jesus warned us about not everyone who calls Him 'Lord' will enter the kingdom?
