Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5.7, Joshua 24.15, Genesis 2.18



**Introduction:** We live in a world of conflict and competing views about masculinity, what it truly means to be a man or manly. The **biblical** view from the Scriptures teaches:

## In the beginning...(Genesis 1):

- a) God made man in His image (reflection)
- b) God made man distinct (recognizable)
- c) God made man for headship (role)
- d) God made man to walk with Him (relationship)

'Biblical masculinity is a man who is physically **recognizable** as a male, **reflects** God's character, walks in daily **relationship** with Him, and embraces his **role** as **head** of the home and a leader of the community.'

'When you respect men's headship, it reflects your honor of God.'

**Problem**: A lack of reverence for man's headship disrupts God's order, covering and blessings for marriage, family, and community, and opens the door to dishonor, chaos, and even judgment.

- c) How do Christ followers navigate masculinity in a time of gender equality?
