Objective: To encourage Christ Followers to remain ready to give a reason for the hope they have in Jesus Christ.

- 1. The _____ of My Hope We put our hope in the Lord. He is our help and our shield. ²¹ In him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in his holy name. ²² Let your unfailing love surround us, Lord, for our hope is in you alone.
 - Our hope is not found in possessions, status, or wealth.
 - Our hope is found in the promises of God, through the finished work of Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 2. _____ from Hope Isaiah 40:31 But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.
 - Circumstances in life can create despair.
 - Knowing God's promises and trusting his word gives us supernatural power to persevere through difficult times.
- 3. _____ of my Hope Hebrews 6:19 ¹⁷ God also bound himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly **sure** that he would never change his mind. ¹⁸ So God has given both his promise and his oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to

him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us.

- Our hope is not "wishful" thinking as in hoping you win the lottery.
- Our hope is a confident expectation that God's promises will be realized in our lives.
- 4. ______ in my Hope John 10:27-30 ²⁷ My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me, ²⁹ for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father's hand. ³⁰ The Father and I are one."
 - Our hope is secure because it is anchored in God's unchanging promises, not our changing circumstances.
 - Because of trials, my faith may get shaken but they cannot break what God has secured.
- 5. ____ my Hope ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
 - Sharing our hope isn't just about what we say, it's about how we live.
 - When we live with Biblical integrity, our lives become a visible testimony.

TAKEAWAY: A hope worth having, is a hope worth sharing. We should all be ready to speak it, live it, and defend it.
