Scripture: Psalms 27.8 (NKJV)



of God: When you said, 'Seek My face.' God desires a two-way relationship. God initiates relationship with us to come close to Him into His presence. James 4.8

Introduction: Our Scripture beautifully captures God's desire for a close relationship

In the beginning...Genesis 1.27. 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to our likeness...' (NKJV)

- Created by God intentionally
- In His image reflect His nature
- For His purpose carry out His plan
- God intentionally made you for relationship. You are known by Him, loved by Him, and pursued by Him.
- He created you in His image to reflect His nature, so that you can belong to Him, know Him, and walk with Him. He did this so you can carry out His purpose for creation. 2 Corinthians 5.19, Revelation 21.3
- 2. _____ of God: 'My heart said to you.' This is a conscious decision to seek God actively and intentionally from the heart.
 - Your pursuit of God expresses a longing from your heart, not just your head, to know Him personally. Matthew 15.8, Romans 10.9
- 3. ______ of God: 'Your face, Lord, I will seek.' It's a promise you make to God. You seek God with your whole heart to speak with Him face to face.
 - It's transformative. You come as you are, but don't stay as you are because in God's presence, His presence is transformational. Your head knowledge becomes heart knowledge. Jeremiah 29.13, Psalms 119.11, John 14.21
 - Friend of God: Psalms 25.14. The secret of the Lord is with those who fear
 Him, and He will show them His covenant (to make known His knowledge,
 His emotions, and His desires). James 2.23, Exodus 33.11, Psalms 103.7,
 John 15.15

In His Presence – God is Spirit

1. Knowledge – know what He knows

- 2. Emotions feel what He feels
- 3. Desires you see what he sees

Relationship with God grows like any relationship, over time. It's not about being perfect, it about being present with an open heart to know what He knows, feel what He feels, and see what He sees.

- 1. Am I seeking God with my whole heart, or just through the motions?
- Do I make my head knowledge (information) heart knowledge (transformation)?
- 3. Do I get information from Scriptures or intimacy from the Scriptures?
- 4. Do I speak honestly with God about my feelings toward Him?
- 5. Do I seek God more to be with Him or for what He can do for me?
