**Definition**: A Christian influencer uses their life to share their Christian beliefs, values, and teachings, so they can inspire or guide others to follow Christ.

**Overall:** Being an influencer is not optional. We're called to live countercultural life that radiates the light and truth of Jesus in a culture that's wandering in darkness. Matthew 5.14

Proverbs 18.10. The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe. (NIV)

- a) **Intercessor**: target list, who you want to reach
- b) **Identify**: what are the barriers (racial, religion, status, etc.)
- c) **Initiate:** build a strong tower that the saved and lost can run to it and build relationships based on truth and transparency through community groups, podcasts, social media, one-on-one friendships, bible studies...
- d) **Inspire**: Christlike life that is unshakable, protective, strengthens, and reliable, encouraging them to follow Christ
