Not talking about a fake-it-till-you make it situation Walk in the truth of who God says you are in Christ It's a fact! Don't let the devil tell you otherwise God to grow you in Christ. 6. Romans 12:2 – Renew your mind Growth has to be intentional Prayer; studying the scriptures; fellowshipping with believers
